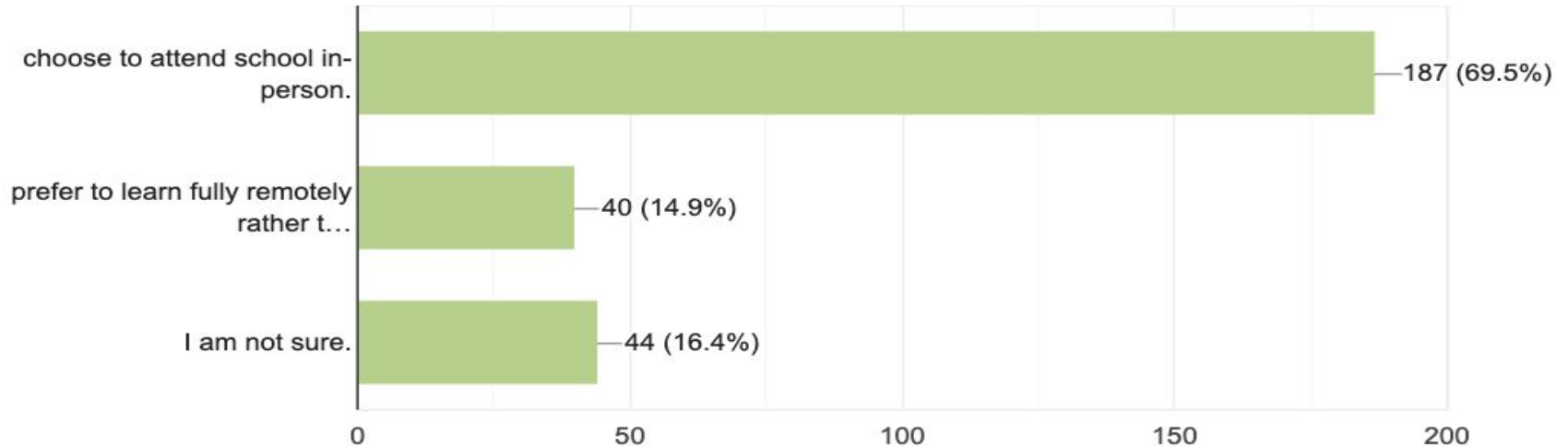

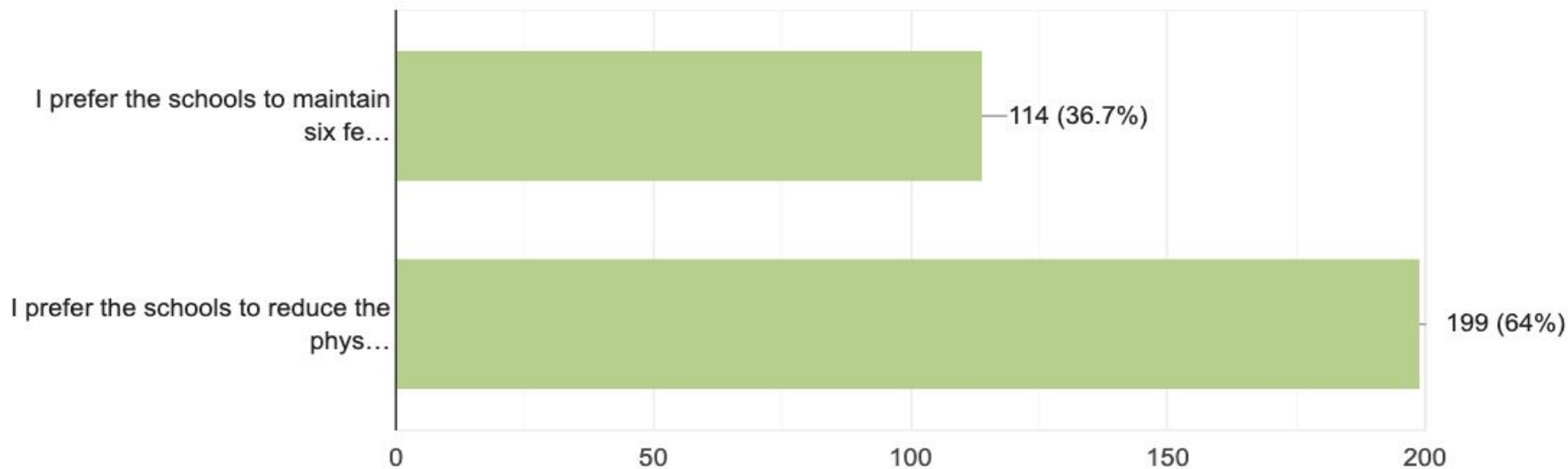

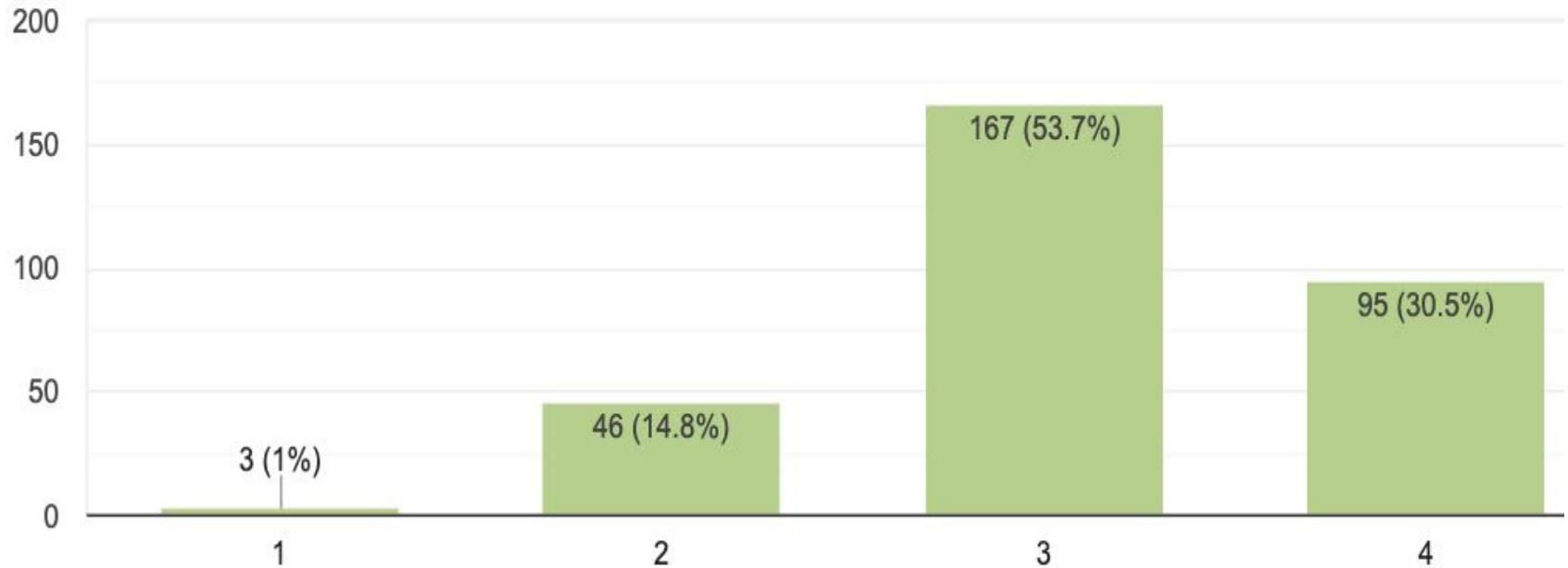

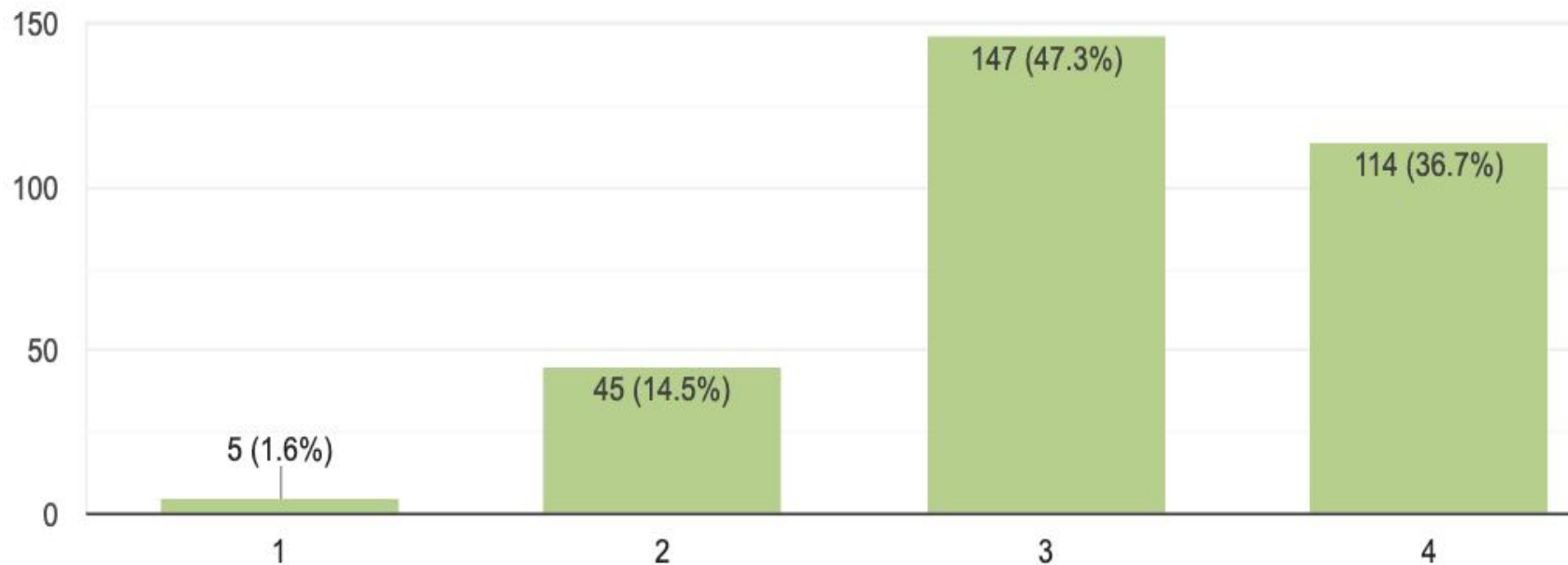

Students are able to meet the lesson objectives independently

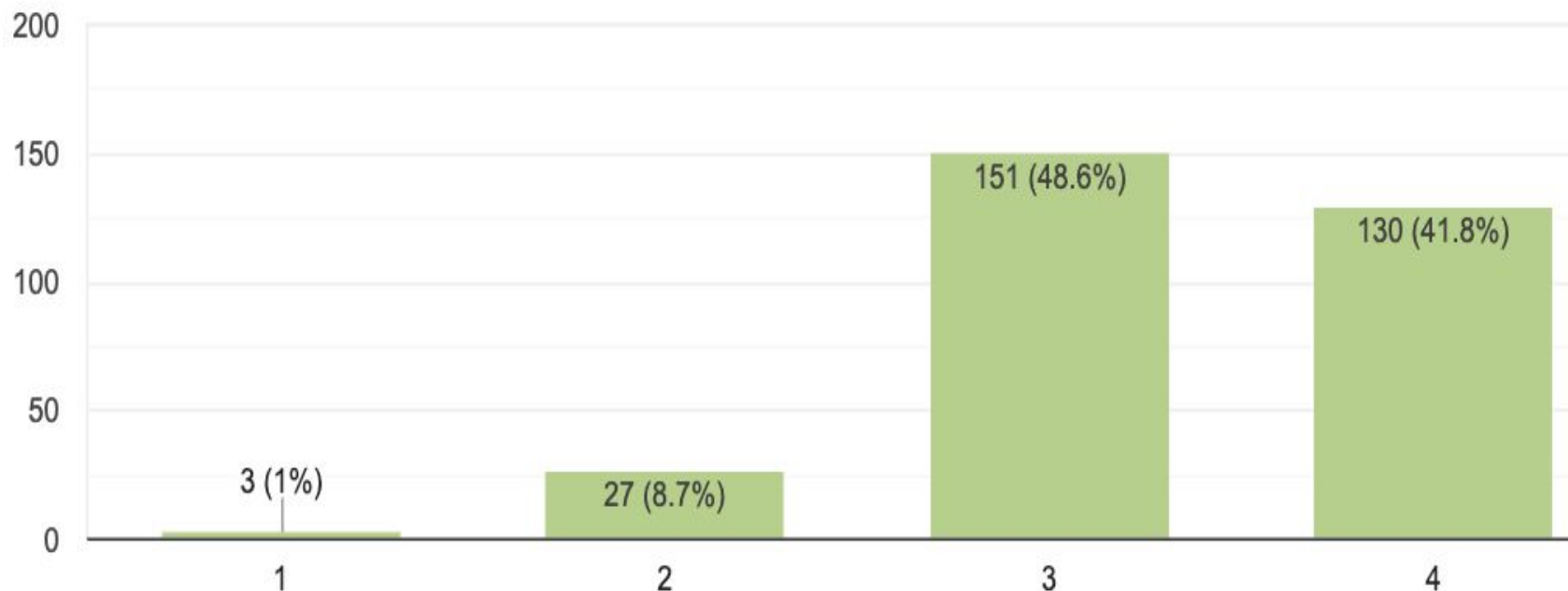

Teachers are adequately prepared for each live lesson

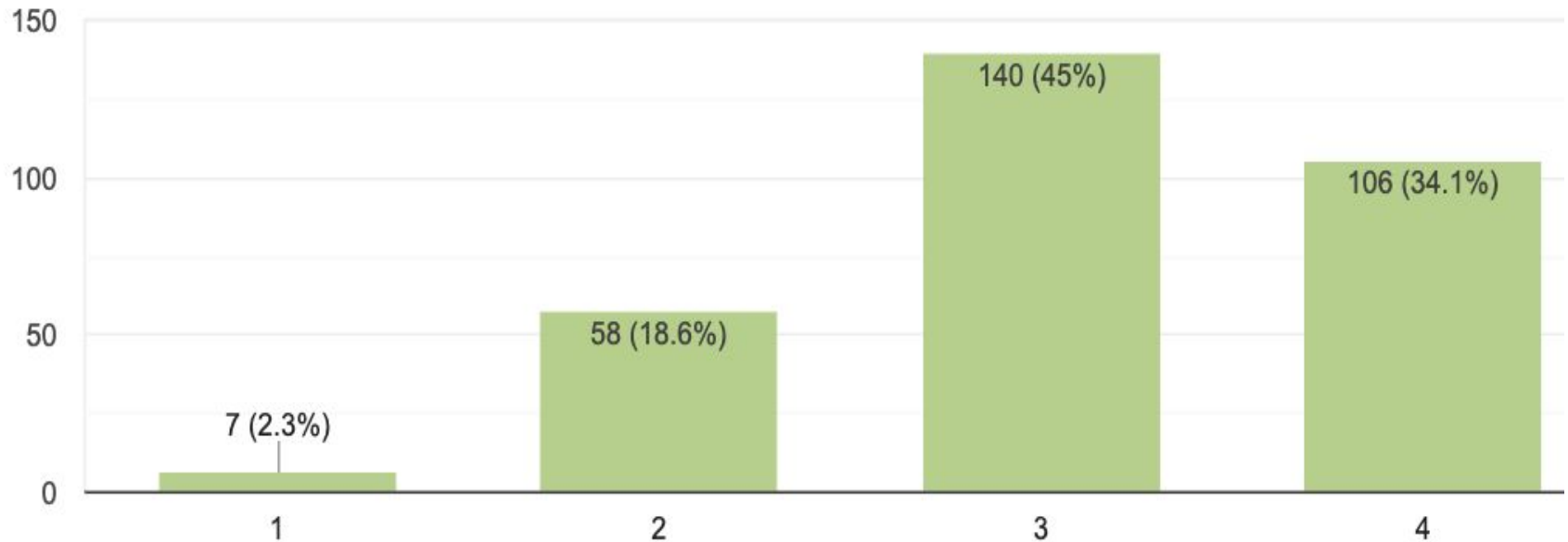

Teachers provide meaningful assignments that fill 90-100% of students' asynchronous learning time (at-home learning days or when teacher is absent).

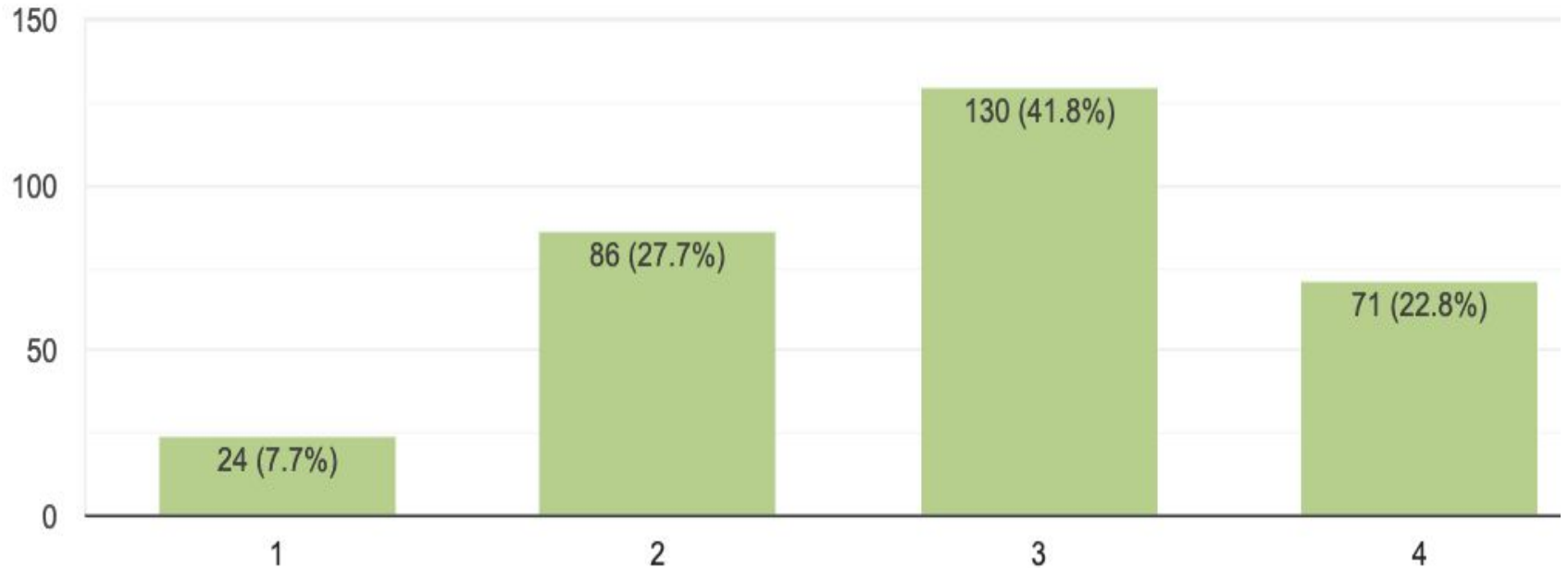

Students are highly engaged in live lessons

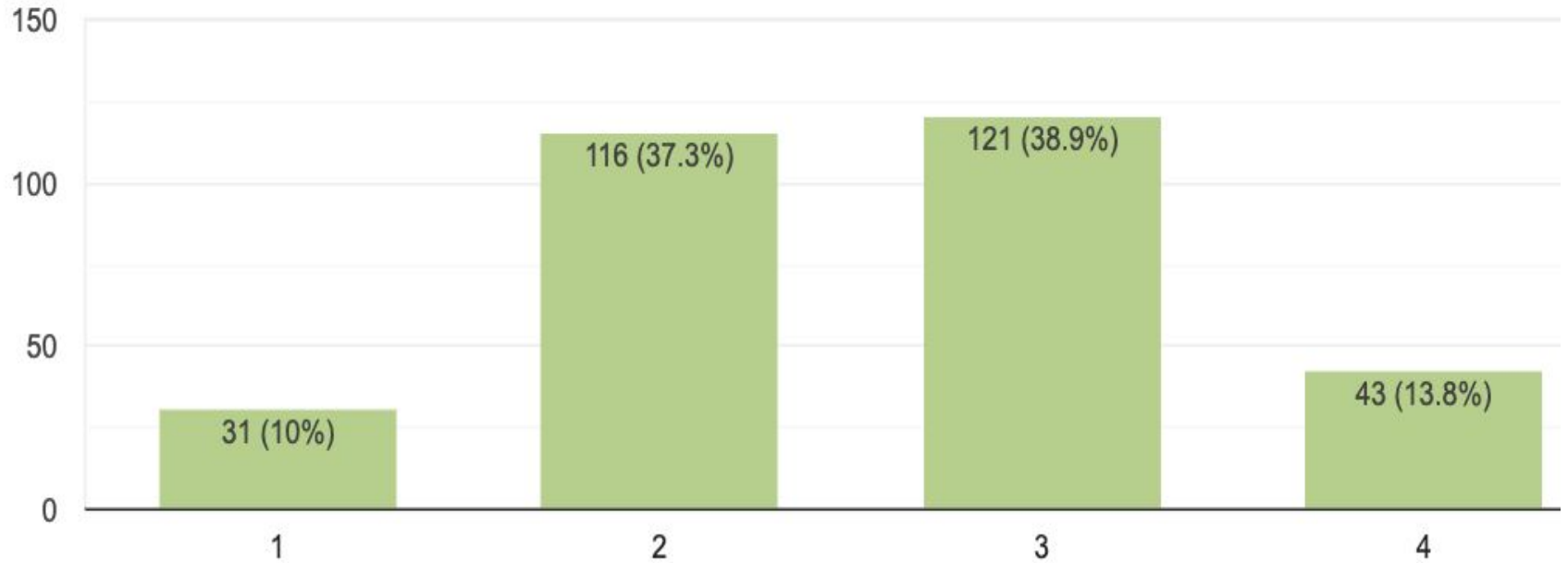

Students are highly engaged in asynchronous lessons

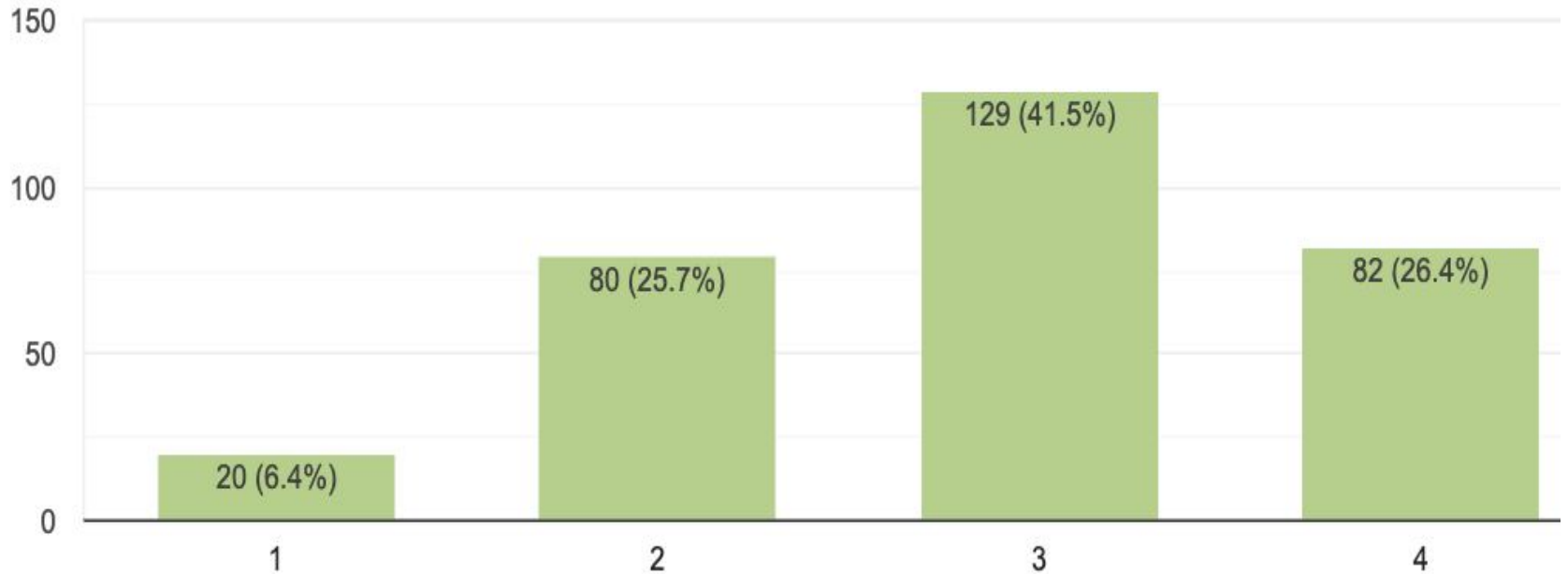

Live lessons provide opportunities to collaborate and engage with other students online

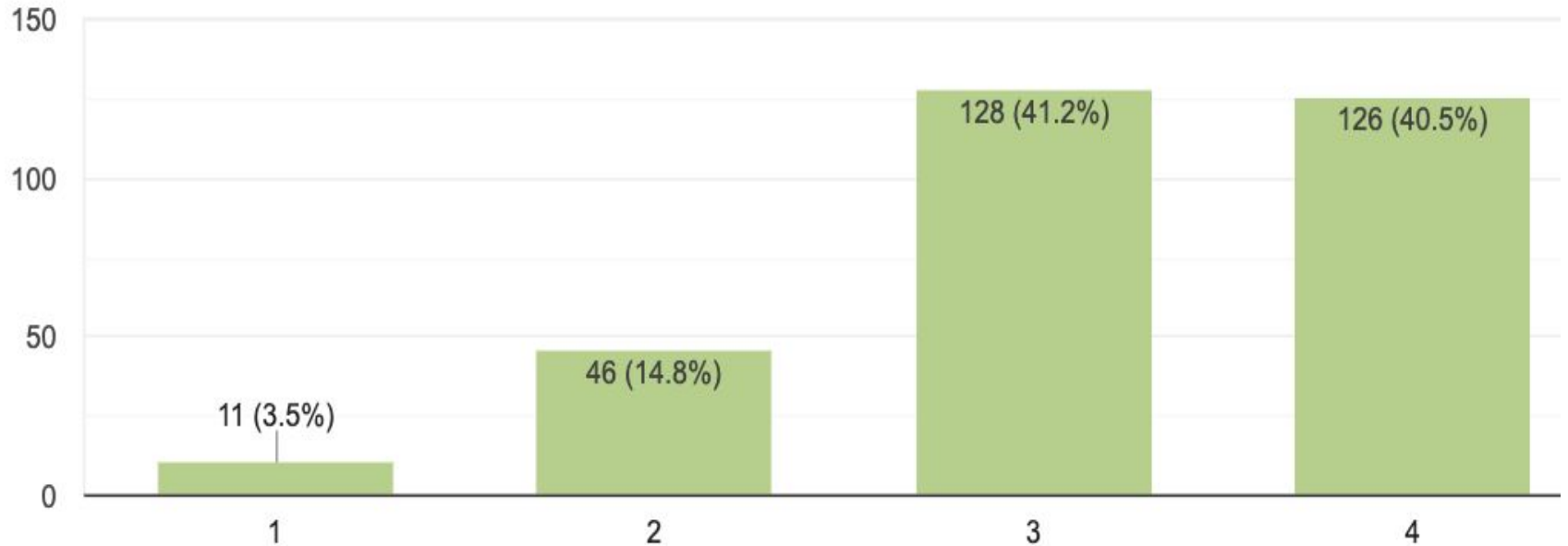

Student has access to support from teachers and/or paraprofessionals as needed.

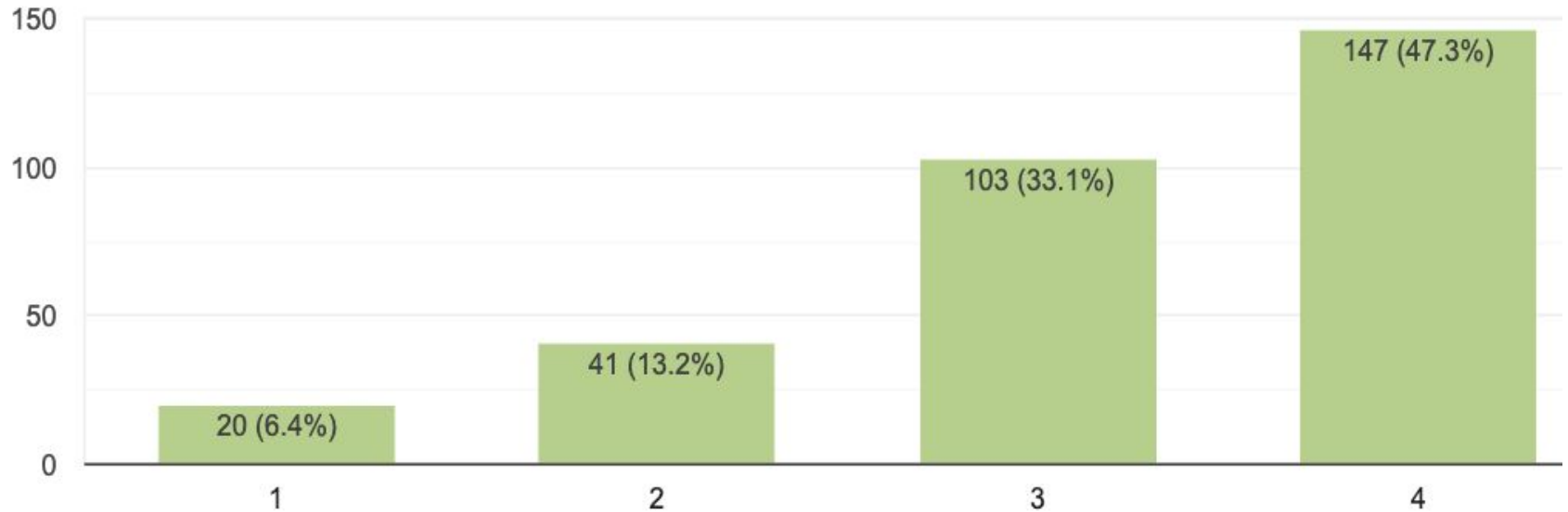

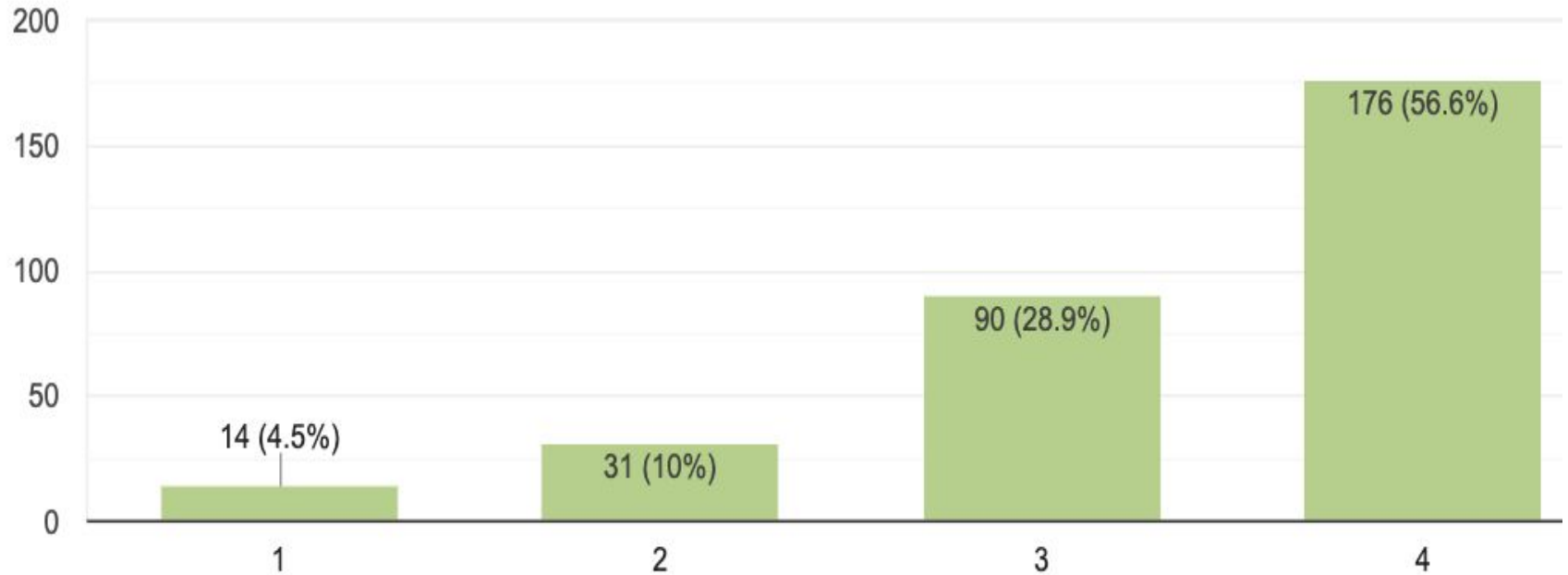
